THE DR. KEN CLOUGH COLLECTION OF CAYMAN ISLANDS

The following section of Cayman Islands adhesives and Postal History includes the valuable collection formed by the late Dr. Ken Clough of Bury, Lancashire. It comprises the finest collection of Cayman Islands that we have seen in many years and includes several of the major rarities essential to a top class collection of these islands. Highlights include a very good selection of KEVII surcharged adhesives, a fine example of the "Postage Paid G.A.P." manuscript provisional on cover, four rare Rural Post covers/cards and a deepened die proof of the 1d design for the Postal Stationery card and envelope. Ken exhibited his Cayman Islands twice nationally: he received a silver medal at the 1966 "Stampex" for his King Edward VII and a silver medal for his 1900-26 exhibit at B.P.E. in 1971. Further important collections formed by Dr. Clough will appear later in the year, with his magnificent holdings of Gibraltar and Morocco Agencies now being prepared for our June auction; Cavendish will then auction his superb Malta in the Autumn.

THE TONY SHEPHERD COLLECTION OF GRENADA STAMPS & POSTAL HISTORY.

The following 90 lots of Grenada include the interesting and valuable collection formed by Tony Shepherd of Halifax. Good collections of this island come to auction very infrequently and we are very pleased to be able to offer such a comprehensive range of Grenada Postal History and adhesives in this West Indies themed auction. Tony's main collecting interest focused on the Postal History of the island with a particular emphasis on village cancellations. Some of the most appealing items from his collection are the 1790 EL from Grenada to Derbyshire with a lovely strike of the encircled "GRENADA/(crown)" mark on the flap, the rare "PAID/AT/GRENADA" crowned circle on the 1854 cover to Scotland, the amazing 1867 "LATE FEE" cover to Demerara and the splendid range of village cancellations on cover. We have not seen such a comprehensive holding of Grenada for many years and now is the perfect opportunity for aficionados of the postal history of this island to add some of Tony's gems to their own collections.
