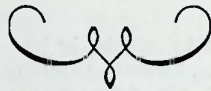

1. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue. The right is reserved to withdraw any lot prior to sale, or to group two or more lots.
2. The highest bidder shall prevail. Should any dispute arise between bidders the decision of the auctioneer, in the exercise of his judgement, as to the successful bidder shall be final, and the auctioneer may reoffer and resell the lots under dispute. Title shall remain in us (Carl E. Pelander) until payment is received and delivery made to the buyer.
3. In the case of floor bidders the name and address of the buyer of each lot shall be given to the auctioneer immediately following the sale of such lot. Payment of the whole purchase price, or such part thereof as we may require, shall be made by the floor buyer in such manner as the auctioneer may determine
4. Successful mail bidders will be notified of lots allocated to them and must remit before the lots are sent. Delivery to successful mail bidders will be at the addresses indicated on their bid sheets. Persons known to us, or who furnish satisfactory references, may, at our option, have their stamps forwarded to them for immediate payment. ALEXANDER PRESTON WATTS



The Alexander Preston Watts Collections, now offered at public auction, served their late owner well, having given him untold pleasure during the several years it took him to amass them.

Mr. Watts was a native New Yorker, having been born here on March 25th, 1888. From early childhood Philately was his one love. Like many others he started out as a general collector, later specializing in the stamps of several countries, however, about 12 years ago he disposed of most of his collections, only retaining his Jamaica and Samoa, which were built up to rank with the best in the world.— These collections were frequently shown at various National and International Exhibitions and won the owner many high awards.

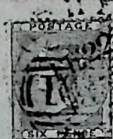
Apart from his philatelic activities, Mr. Watts, was a Mason of high standing. He served as Master of his blue lodge, Ancient Lodge 724 F. & A. M. and later served as Grand Steward of the Grand Lodge of the State of New York. He was also very active in the Knights Templars. Besides these Masonic activities, he was a member of the Advertising Club of New York, the Collectors Club and the Masonic Stamp Club, also serving as Trustee of the George Washington Memorial Shrine at Tappan, N. Y. He was always interested in aiding the more unfortunate and served as Director in the Federation for the Handicapped and devoted a great deal of time in working for the blind.

In disposing of these collections, we trust that the recipients will receive a small portion of the pleasure it gave Mr. Watts.
